A MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER

Since Nassau Intergroup has always been a totally volunteer operation it has always sought to develop means to simplify its accounting process yet maintain a high level of efficiency. The Group ID number system was developed for this purpose. Under this system each group has its own individual Nassau Intergroup (NIG) number. This number identifies *your* group and *your* group only. **It is used in the Nassau Meeting List, which is the number listed just to the right of the group's name.** This NIG # makes identification much easier as it corresponds in the databases for easier identification searches.

When your Group makes a donation either by check or money order you should include the NIG# on the check or money order. Why? Without this number it could be difficult to know exactly which group made the donation. Some groups share the same rental space while other groups have the same name of another group or groups meeting in a different part of Nassau. With the NIG# it is quite simpler then, to attribute the correct source of any and all contributions. So please help us to be both more responsive and responsible to you the Groups by using your NIG#.
