The 20th Annual Central Office/Intergroup A.A.W.S. Seminar was held in Charlotte, North Carolina 9/29-10/2. The theme was "A Declaration Unity." As always the weekend was an opportunity to exchange ideas and information on how best to do our 12th Step work. There were 150 attendees from all over the United States and Canada. Before Cynthia and I left we were charged by the Reps to see what sort of help could be offered to the Central Offices and Intergroups so devastatingly affected by hurricane Katrina. At the time of the Seminar it was the general feeling that the best support we could collectively offer the Gulf State members was love and prayers. There was a comprehensive overview of such disasters covered in Box 459 published by GSO.
